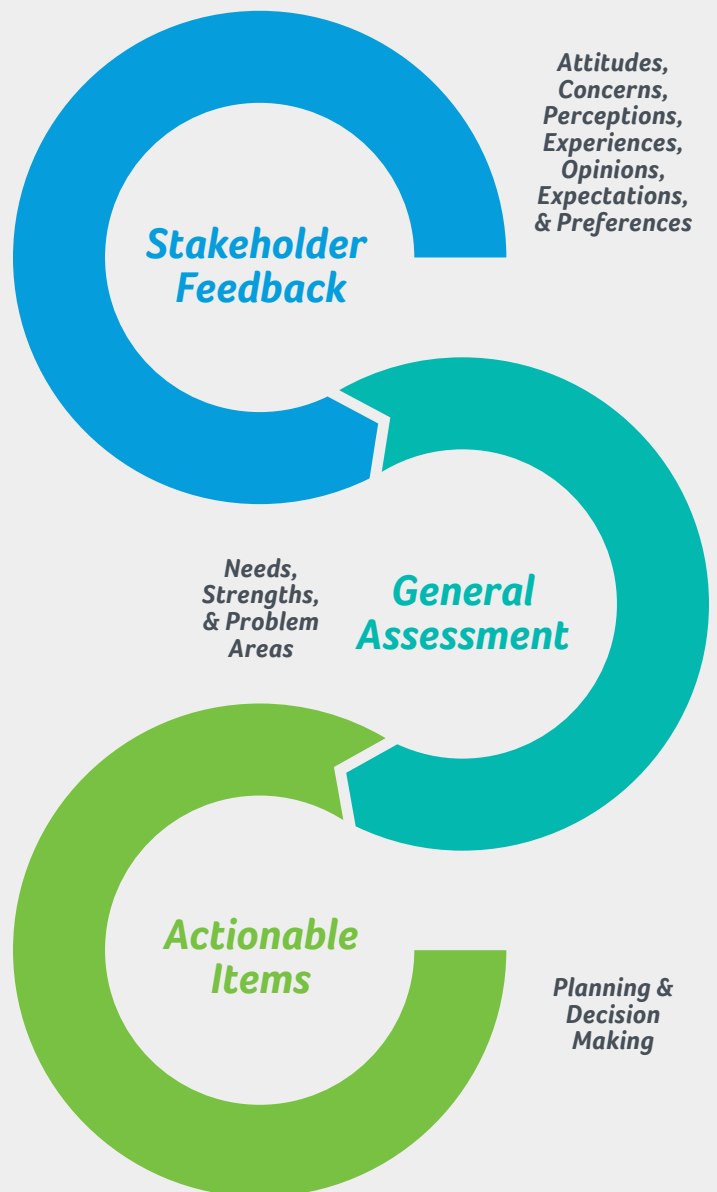

Usually mailed home for middle and high school students; often “backpacked” home with elementary students. Generally includes a business reply envelope for the parents to return the survey to Scantron. <i>Advantage: Ensures likelihood of parents receiving the survey and they are more likely to respond.</i>	
Distributed various ways; can be administered and taken online, each invitation and response having numerical codes tying back to a specific school. <i>Advantage: Parents may be more inclined to respond because it is easy and fast.</i>	
Distributed during parent-teacher conferences or other school events. <i>Advantage: Captive audience.</i>
