

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
100 - Test Analysis Report

The Test Analysis Report offers a comprehensive summary and highlights key issues in the test, such as questions where a distractor is selected more frequently than the correct answer, students displaying significant patterns of correct/incorrect responses, and test questions that show poor correlation.




101 - Student Statistics Report

The Student Statistics Report provides an overview of each student's performance on the test. It optionally includes their scores on learning objectives, objective questions, and subjective questions. This report is ideal for quickly assessing student performance and determining if they are meeting the required standards.




105 - Student Response Report

The Student Response Report presents a matrix view of each student's answers to the test questions, with selected answers displayed and color-coded to indicate correctness. This report allows for a quick assessment of performance at both the student and question levels.




111 - Class Learning Objectives Report

The Class Learning Objectives Report shows the class average percentage and grade for each learning objective, as well as for the overall test. It also includes the average number of objective and subjective points earned within each learning objective. Learning objectives can be sorted by name or by the total points available. Additionally, the report can display the number of questions answered correctly or incorrectly.




112 - Student Achievement Report

The Student Achievement Report highlights each student's performance on the overall test and specific learning objectives. Scores can be compared against a benchmark value. This report provides a quick overview of who has mastered the subject matter and who has not. It can also be emailed directly to students.




150 - Student Grade Report

The Student Grade Report offers detailed test information for each student, making it suitable for distribution to students, parents, or teachers. If a benchmark score is defined in the answer key, the report includes a bar chart comparing the student's score to the benchmark. If learning objectives are specified, it displays the score for each objective alongside the overall test score.




151 - Student Test Report

The Student Test Report includes an annotated scanned image of the student's test form. Annotations feature the test grade, responses (correct or incorrect) for each multiple-choice question, optionally the correct answer, and points awarded for each open-response item. Any instructor comments are also included. This report can be emailed to students. **Not available for online tests.**




170 - Student Feedback Report

The Student Feedback Report provides grade details for the overall test and any learning objectives covered, along with the students' answers to selected questions. It also includes any comments from the grader. This report can be emailed to students.




204 - Condensed Item Analysis Report

The Condensed Item Analysis Report shows how often each answer choice was selected, helping to assess the validity of each question. The bar chart highlights correct and incorrect options, and flags cases where more students chose an incorrect answer than the correct one, which may suggest an issue with the answer key. Any identified issues can be resolved by editing the answer key, after which the student data is automatically regraded.




206 - Condensed Test Report

The Condensed Test Report presents answer choice frequency data for each question, along with distractor and class score information. It's an effective way to quickly assess both individual questions and overall class performance.



310 -Test Statistics Report

The Test Statistics Report provides detailed statistics for both the overall test and learning objectives. These include the total possible test points, the number of graded items, and the highest and lowest scores. Additional statistics cover the mean, benchmark, range, standard deviation, and variance. Percentile information includes the 25th and 75th percentiles, interquartile range, and median score. Confidence intervals are provided at the 1%, 5%, 95%, and 99% levels. The report also includes test reliability metrics, such as Kuder-Richardson and Cronbach Alpha statistics.



320 -Test Item Statistics Report

The Test Item Statistics Report provides basic statistics for each question on the test. These include the point value, the number of graded responses, the number of students who answered correctly, incorrectly, or left it unanswered, and the percentage of students who answered the question correctly. The point biserial is also calculated. Questions can be sorted by name, percent correct, or point biserial.
